Materials

Khaki color cotton gabardine, gray cashmere stocking-stitch knit, gray cashmere broken-rib knit, raw cotton cloth, nut brown-on-white stripe lining fabric, tape with name GIANFRANCO FERRE in black

Working processes

Description

Short slim doublebreasted jacket. Felled collar with fillet insert, button strap closure. Straight padded shoulders, collar badges with loop. Long round sleeves with buckle strap cuffs. Bavolet over shoulders. Mid back box pleat with button strap closure at bottom hem. On sides, concave cut with collar effect similar to one at neck, for a fresh take on the basque. Matching belt with buckle/metal ring closure, army mode.
Casual wide-leg pants with tucks, broad belt with buckle/strap fastening. Four button-down flap pockets.
Long straight stocking-stitch V-neck cardigan. Knit in T shape, with straight armholes and long dropped broken-rib sleeves. Patch pocket on left front.

Remarks

Ferré turns to sportswear to rethink the codes of classy urban style. This outfit is part of a whole series of gabardine items capturing a totally new idea of the military trench coat. The designer's research results in a disassembling and reassembling of this ultratraditional garment. The collar becomes a basque or a pocket flap, while lapels shift downward as if tails. In the process, most likely using authentic vintage pieces.
