**The exhibition "Gianfranco Ferré. Under another light: Jewels and Ornaments"
prolonged until Monday 2 April.**

Turin - Palazzo Madama - Sala del Senato

The exhibition, inaugurated on last October 12th, organized and produced by the Gianfranco Ferré Foundation in collaboration with the Torino Musei Foundation has reached **60,000** visitors to date. With the intention of further increasing this significant success, it was decided to prolong the exhibition until April 2nd, Easter Monday.

The appreciation rate of the exhibit dedicated to the jewels and jewel-pieces of clothing created by Gianfranco Ferré during his over thirty years of his creative activity has been extremely high. Formal, material and aesthetic research is one of the elements perfectly defining all the 250 pieces on display, enhanced by the curatorialship of Francesca Alfano Miglietti.

The set up by Architect Franco Raggi earned a significant success, which brings out the richness of the objects on display opposing intentionally "poor" structures with the magnificence of the Sala del Senato in Palazzo Madama.
